# **Serving Guide: Prayer**



The way prayers are led publicly in church has an impact on the nature and shape of Church attenders prayer lives. For this reason it is very important for prayer at church services to be exemplary models of praying. A good model of praying includes far more than just asking God for stuff... it should also include words of adoration about God for His greatness, confession to God for our misgivings and thanksgiving to God for His faithfulness because of Jesus. With this in mind, a good model for leading public prayers at WWEC is the **A.C.T.S** model:

#### A = Adoration

This is a prayer where we express our love for God, giving him praise and honor for who he is. It is critical to always include an adoration prayer in each of our Sunday services because it expresses the heartbeat of our church family - which is the magnification of God's name. The importance of magnifying God's name needs to be at the forefront of everyone's vision week in and week out and so it is important to pray Adoration prayers each week. Another reason why it is so critical to always include adoration prayers is because Australian culture is very poor at communicating affection to people, let alone to God. Our people do need help to be regularly praying adoration prayers in their lives. A good way to write an adoration prayer is to complete the following sentence: *Heavenly Father, we love you because...* 

### C = Confession

This is where we pray in a way that honestly admits our sin to our God and explicitly seeks his forgiveness. When you prepare confession prayers be careful to include the language of "we" not "f". As the prayer leader, you are leading the congregation in prayer and so it is important to use corporate language to reflect this. Another key aspect to consider when praying prayers of confession is to avoid language that makes excuses. Many prayers of confession are littered with excuses to God as to why we behaved the way we did. We want to avoid such excuse making at WWEC and instead have a clear confession of our sins without any self justifications or minimizations. As God clearly does offer full forgiveness to his people, it is important to give people an assurance of the forgiveness of their sins in Christ as part of this prayer. A good way to write a confession prayer is to complete the following sentence: **Heavenly Father, we are sorry because**...

## T = Thanksgiving

Verbalize to God what it is you're so grateful for in your life and in the world around you. We are more well practiced at praying thank you prayers, but that does not make it any less important. A good way to write a thanksgiving prayer is to complete the following sentence: *Heavenly Father, we thank you for.*..

## S = Supplication

These are request prayers, where we pray for the needs of others and ourselves. While there are many things to rightly request God about, the focus of our request prayers changes each Sunday reflecting our "M" purpose areas of Mission, Membership, Maturity, Ministry. A good way to write a supplication prayer is to complete the following sentence: *Heavenly Father, we ask that....* 

To help you do this – here is a guideline of things we should regularly be praying for in church. Please add current events or prayer points from the Church family as necessary.
